# OJ Electronics Cookies Policy

OJ Electronics' website (hereafter referred to as the Website) uses cookies. By using the Website, you accept the Website's use of cookies as stated below.

On December 14th 2011 the so-called "Cookie Directive" went into force. The legislation has two essential elements: the user should receive adequate information about the cookies that are in use on the website; and cookies may only be used when the user consents to this.

## How does OJ Electronics use cookies?

OJ Electronics strives to give the visitors to our website the best possible experience, and therefore want to analyze traffic and behavior. We use the information to improve the contents of our website and to give our visitors a good impression of our website and company.

We never share any information with other companies.

## What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer. Cookies can contain text and numbers, such as dates. Cookies are not programs and do not contain viruses or similar malicious code. Cookies are used to that a website can store specific information about the user so that the website later can recognize the user or load the information contained within the cookie. It may, for example, include login information, information on previous visits, and which parts of the site you visited. Cookies can only be read by the address (website) they are saved at

Some cookies (called session cookies) are saved in a browser session, and are deleted when the browser is shut down. Other cookies (so-called persistent cookies) are stored for a defined period of time, and will be deleted at the end of this period.

## Which cookies use the website and why?

The website uses the following cookies:

- 1. In connection with log-in information:** A "persistent cookie". It contains encrypted information about the user name and password to the extent that you make use of the Website log-in feature. The cookie has a lifetime of one (1) month, and is deleted one month after the last time you made use of the Website log-in feature. This cookie is used to remember you when you return to the Website, without you having to sign in again.
- 2. In connection with the date of your last visit:** A persistent cookie. It contains information about the date of your last visit to the website and is used for statistical purposes. The cookie has a lifetime of one (1) year, and it is deleted one year after your last visit to the website.
- 3. In previous visits:** A persistent cookie. It contains a unique ID given to you when visiting the website. It is used for statistical purposes. The cookie has a lifetime of one (1) year, and it is deleted one year after your last visit to the Website.

## How can I avoid the use of cookies on the Website?

No matter which browser you use, you can, within the browser settings, set this so that it does not store cookies. In some browsers you can also choose which websites this should apply to.
